Enchantress is a contemporary dance trio choreographed by Jessica Lowe, alongside dancers Sarah Hopkin and Marrin Jessome. The piece revolves around a massive parachute skirt designed by Olivia Aubrecht. The feminist work depicts the journey of a woman's life through the modern pagan traditions of "The Triple Goddess", which breaks down a woman's life into three phases "Mother, Maiden & Crone". Each dancer in the work represents one of these phases, showing the passage of time and age. The massive skirt which is passed between the dancers is the through-line connecting each phase of a woman's life. The skirt represents the weight, burden and beauty of aging as a woman. The audience should expect to watch a highly physical and theatrical work, paired with an accessible coming of age store about womanhood.
